

ZF:

I will denote the set of a set-definition X as $S(X)$.

Let M be the set-definition

$$\{\text{set-definition } X \mid X \notin S(X)\}.$$

Therefore:

$$M \in S(M) \Leftrightarrow M \notin S(M).$$
